New German project to develop a reliable earthquake forecast

The Haiti M 7.0 quake on January 12 shows to all of us the total helplessness of people in areas hit by severe earthquakes. Until today there is no possibility to avoid casualties from such catastrophes because nobody can predict the quakes.

We intend to change this unacceptable situation by developing a reliable "earthquake forecast" much like the weather forecast. This project comes after years of observing and studying seismic data and other parameters which show precursory signs before strong quakes arrive.

Please have a look at the attachments which contain a short introduction to our project and a prediction for one or more upcoming quakes with very high magnitude.

We also send this information to other media in earthquake prone countries around the world to let them know now, that we are developing a earthquake forecasting tool which will help minimize the loss of human life wherever strong earthquakes occur.
